On Wednesday we continued with a social lesson about positive self talk and how our words effect other people. Sometimes our words can hurt more than anything. We have began introducing the "yellow light" the moments we need to pause our thoughts, bodies, and words before we release a "bubble thought". These tools help us with our self regulation and impulsivity. Every student benefits from having multiple tools encourage positive interactions with all their communication. We are cruising through word study each day. Every grade level has been working on their math and reading goals throughout the week. It has been a great week with lots of progress and learning during focus time.
